At age 8, she was invited to become a member of one of Atlanta's leading dance competition companies, Roswell City Dance (now Company 23), under the direction of Shannon Childers and Cherrise Wakeham. She was a member of RCD from ages 8 to 18 where she intensely studied ballet, pointe, jazz, tap, hip hop, lyrical, contemporary, musical theater and acrobatics, and won numerous 1st overall awards at the most prestigious regional and national competitions such as NYCDA, Starpower, Showstopper, Celebrity, Hall of Fame, etc.. Katy has worked, individually, with many of the world's top choreographers such as Travis Wall, Dennis Caspary, Mia Michaels, and Cherrise Wakeham, and studied acrobatics under several Olympic gymnasts including Olga and Julia Yurkina. Katy knew, from a young age, that she wanted to choreograph and teach dance. At the age of 15, she began teaching young students (ages 2-10) dance, gymnastics, and musical theater, as well as assisting her dance company's acrobatics classes. Katy now lives in Colorado Springs with her husband, dog, cat, and fish and works at a film distribution and production company during the day. In the evenings, she enjoys teaching jazz, tap, hip hop, lyrical, contemporary, musical theater, acrobatics, ballet, pointe and working with all ages and abilities. Katy brings bubbly, vivacious, and technical enthusiasm to each dance room in hopes of lighting a passion for dance in every child she encounters.

Dance Unlimited and its staff believe in giving back to our community. During the holidays we do this in several ways.

First is: Our Christmas Show!

- This becomes a highlight for our dancers and special time to make a difference.
- Our shows are done in nursing homes throughout the community. The dancers love spreading holiday cheer with the • residents.
- Rehearsals will be November 7th, 14th, 21st & December 5th at Dance Unlimited from 12:00-1:15pm (You do not • have to be at all rehearsals to participate.)
- There will be an informational meeting on November 14th during rehearsal! •
- We use the same costume year after year. If you have a costume you would like to sell, please bring to the studio labeled with size, your name and the price you are asking.
- Costume cost for combo dancers is approximately \$32.00 and for everyone else it is approximately \$68.00 if you do • not have tights or black booty shorts.
- There is a one time rehearsal fee of \$15.00 for the first dancer and \$10.00 for each additional dancer in a family. We use this money to buy groceries for the families we adopt.

Second is: Giving back to the community by adopting families to provide them a Christmas!

We will have a Christmas tree at the front counter about mid November. On the tree are tags with the families wishes. Our Dane Unlimited families take tags off the tree and bring then wrapped gift back to DU and then as we get closer to the holidays we set up a delivery time that everyone is welcome to participate in.
